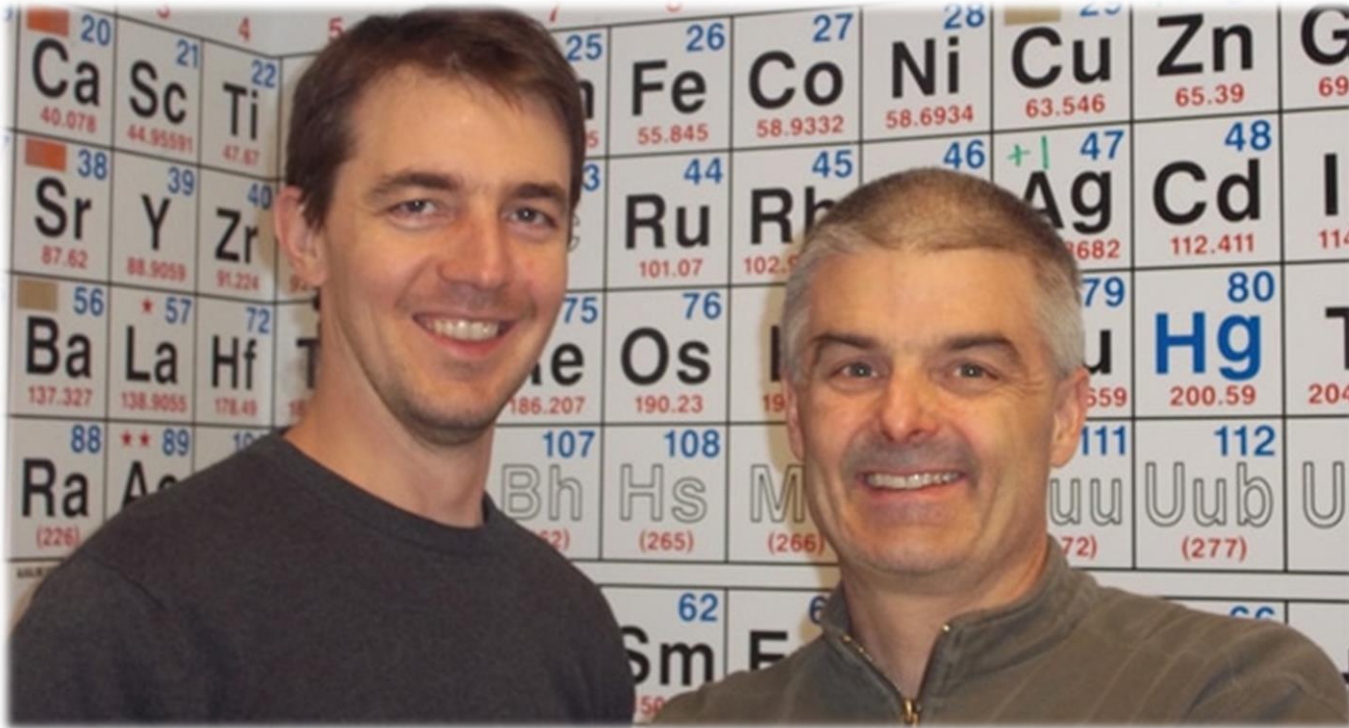

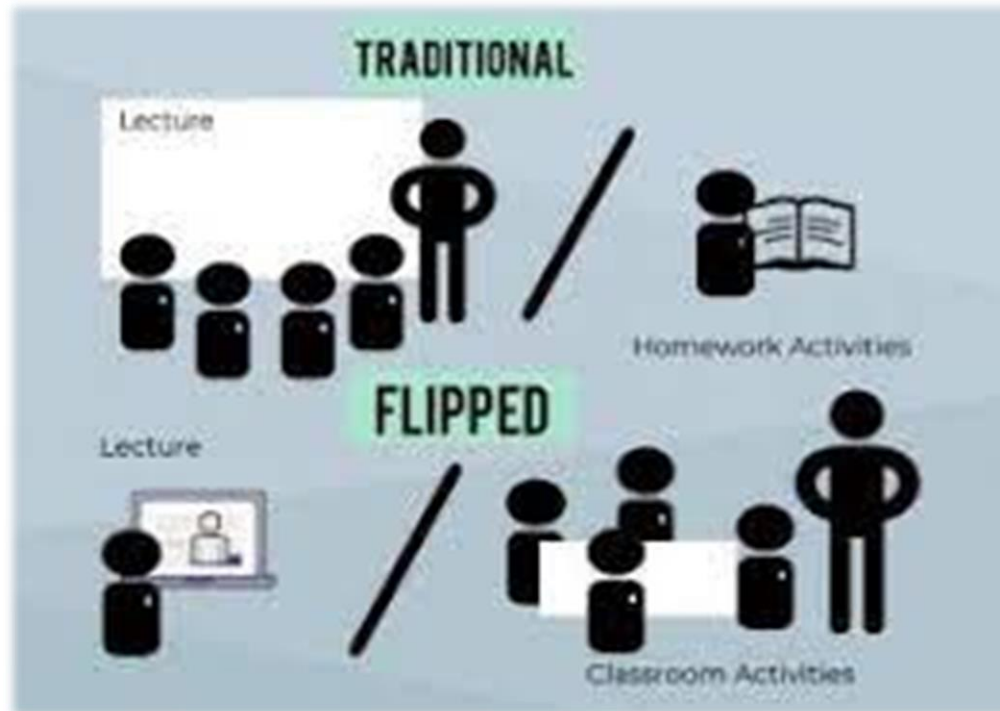

## Benefits of a flipped classroom

- экономит время на занятия;

## Drawbacks of a flipped classroom

- требует много сил и времени от преподавателя для подготовки занятий;
- у студентов недостаточно мотивации для самостоятельной работы над материалом;

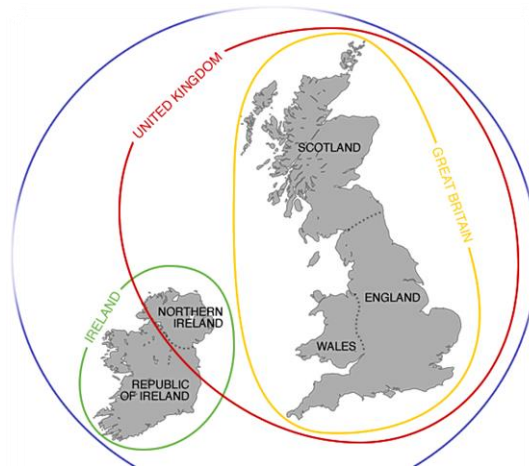

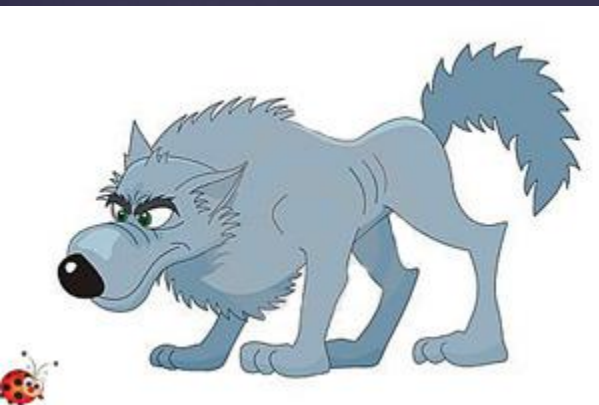
